Hi Jenna,

Again, I apologize if my response wasn't clear. I will try again.

If dredging is the primary concern at this point, here is HCFCD's stance:

The Bond Program does include funding that would provide a portion of the funding for any future dredging work on the East Fork/West Fork/Lake Houston area. Any future dredging project will have to be a collaborative effort between the City of Houston, the Coastal Water Authority, and possibly the State of Texas. At this time, no details have been worked out on future dredging.

I will add another Partnership Project symbol (the green crosses) to the San Jacinto River watershed exhibit and corresponding line item to the Bond Program table that is called East Fork/West Fork/Lake Houston Dredging. The description will be: "Potential Partnership Project with the City of Houston, Coastal Water Authority, and the State of Texas to permit, design, and complete dredging of the East Fork/West Fork/Lake Houston area waterways to reduce flooding risks." I will make the dollar amount \$50M from HCFCD and TBD (to be determined) for the COH, CWA, and State. I do not want to commit or obligate them to spend their money since as of now, HCFCD has no agreement in place with the COH, CWA, or State for the dredging project.
